

# Assembly and User's Guide Spit Grill



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# 1 Product Description

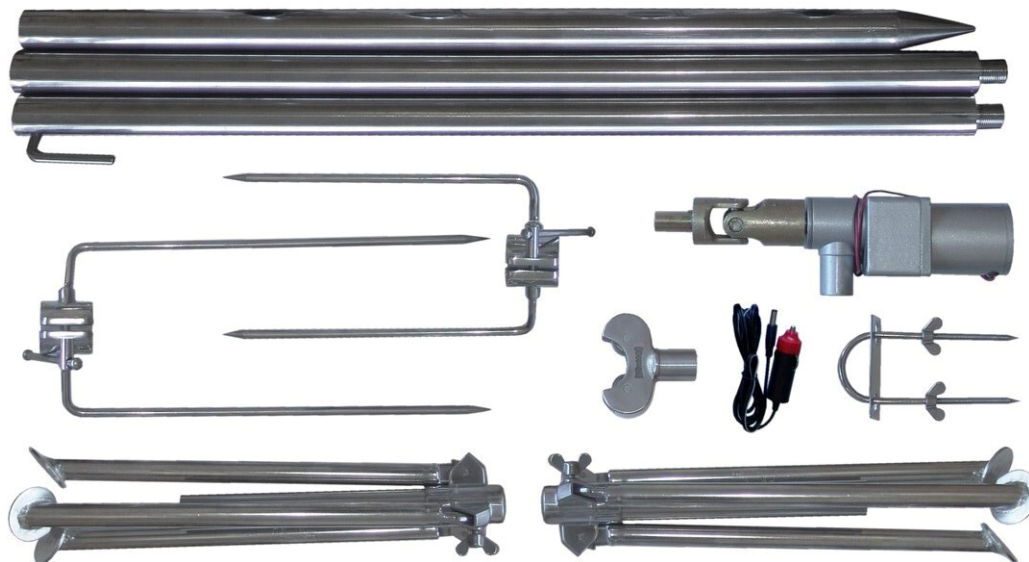
Congratulations on your purchase of this practical stainless steel spit grill! This grill can be used for various items such as suckling pigs, lambs, hocks, etc.

Due to its high quality materials, solid construction and easy assembly and dismantling, this grill is sure to bring you much enjoyment. Packed in a practical carrying case, the grill requires little storage space and can be easily transported to any barbeque place.

# 2 Components

This spit grill includes the following components:



- Carrying case.
- Two tripod stands with extension pipe and locking wing screws.
- An electric motor (12 volt, 1200 mA, about 7 rpm, about 10 Nm of torque, 10 watt capacity, max. grill weight 50 kg) including an extension cable with an adjustable connecting plug for the ordered power connector plug, either for an automobile cigarette lighter socket (or portable battery with a socket for a 12 volt connector plug), a connecting terminal for battery poles, or for a 220 volt transformer.
- Pivot bearing for the spit.
- Three part grill rod (max. load 50 kg):
  - a. One rod with a contact lever for the electric motor at one end and the right-handed screw thread at the other end.
  - b. One rod for the left-handed screw thread at one end and the right-handed screw thread at the other end (extension rod).
  - c. One rod for the left-handed screw thread at one end and the spike at the other end.
- Two double pointed fixing devices for the grill meat including a clamp mounting.
- One additional, U-shaped fixing device with a counter plate and wing screws.

### **3 Assembling the Spit Grill**

To assemble the spit grill, please observe the following steps as they are ordered:

To assemble the spit grill, please observe the following steps as they are ordered:

1. Open the carrying case.
2. Set up both tripods and place the extension pipe at the desired height, fixing it in place with the wing screws.
3. Attach the electric motor on the extension pipe to one of the two tripods.
4. On the second tripod, attach the pivot bearing to the extension pipe.
5. Connect the three-part (or two, if the extension pole is not needed) rod of the spit above the intended screw thread so that the spike on one end of the pole and the fixing device on the other end reach the motor.
6. Affix what you want to grill by thrusting the fixing device over the grill rod and tightening.
7. Attach the one end of the rod to the motor and place the other end in the intended pivot bearing on the second tripod.
8. Connect the motor to the power supply.

Please be careful not to hurt yourself on the sharp edges and tips (such as on the spit ends, the connecting screw threads, fixing device, etc.) when assembling this spit grill!

Note:

When using the battery connecting terminal please observe the direction of rotation when connecting the power supply. The direction of rotation is clockwise from the end of the rod where the motor is attached. The connecting screw threads of the three parts of the rod could come loose if the rod rotates in the wrong direction.

### **4 Dismantling the Spit Grill**

When you are finished grilling, go through the assembly steps in reverse order to dismantle the grill. Allow the grill to sufficiently cool off before dismantling. Thoroughly clean the individual pieces before storing them in the carrying case.

Note:

Due to the type of material, it is typical that the screw threads, particularly those connecting the three pieces of the rod, become very tight during grilling – so much so that it may not be possible to unscrew them by hand. A simple trick remedies this situation: hit the screw threads gently with another harder object, preferably a metal one, in order to release the tension and easily separate the rods. (Wrap the rod with a towel or cloth to avoid damaging any parts).

### **5 Disclaimer**

While assembling and using the grill, please keep minors, especially children, at a safe distance and store the grill in a location not accessible to them.
